**Children can be collected from 3.15pm**

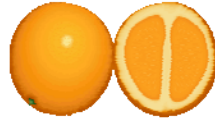

**Can you please supply a water bottle for your child to use in Nursery**

You can buy a school water bottle from Nursery for **£1.30**  
*(please ask a member of staff)*  
Children will only be given water as directed by the LEA.

Nursery children are provided with free school milk every day.

**School registers your child to receive milk.  
Please check 'Cool Milk' Information in your pack**

Your child will need a book bag for their Library book  
Book bags are available to order at **£4.80**  
*(please ask at the main Reception area)*

**Library day is on a Monday and we ask that the books are returned the following Monday.**

## **Helpful hints**

### **Please name all clothing!!**

Uniform is not compulsory, but most children do wear it. Information about ordering uniform is in your Welcome Pack.

**The children will have access to the outdoor area at all times during their Nursery session.**



We provide waterproof coats and trousers for the children when they play outside during the nursery session, but the children will still need to bring their own coat for walking to and from school.

**We also provide wellies for those rainy days!  
As the children will have access to the outdoor area everyday, rain or shine!**



Please ensure that your child has suitable shoes (no open toe sandals).

**Don't forget sun cream and a sun hat in the summer for all those sunny days!!!**

**For safety reasons jewellery is not allowed.**

**Please do not bring your child's toys to school unless asked to do so.**
