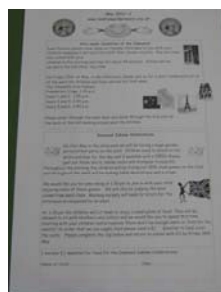

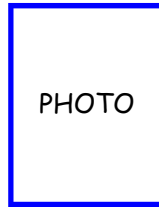

**Please name all clothing!!**

A uniform order form is in your pack.

**The children will have access to the outdoor area at all times during the school day**



We provide waterproof coats & trousers for the children when they play out during the day, but the children will still need to bring their own coat for walking to and from school.

**We also provide wellies for those rainy days! As the children will have access to the outdoor area everyday, rain or shine!**



Please ensure that your child has suitable shoes for school. A copy of our school uniform is in our brochure.
